



Introduction to the work of El Shaddai

The El Shaddai Charitable Trust is a registered, not-for-profit, non-sectarian, and non – religious charity started by Anita Edgar and Matthew Kurian. El Shaddai operates in Goa and other States in India, implementing the Child Rights Act 2003/05 for orphans, street children, and children coming from economically desperate conditions.

The charity cares for and supports underprivileged children and adults living in destitute, providing food, clothing, shelter, and education. We have six Residential Homes housing homeless children, three Day Care Centres, three Community Centres, shelters for destitute adults, four schools, in addition to cottages housing seniors who have left the Residential Homes and are now attending University, Colleges, Technical Institutions and Professional Training Centres or in employment.

Slum School Project – Funding Request

The Slum School Project is a uniquely designed program preparing slum children for formal education by taking the school to them.

We aim to provide 1000 children who are living on the edge, marginalised and deprived of the basic education and health facilities and with no financial security, with an education and comprehensive support services.

Access to education and learning are nonexistent in the slums. There are estimated to be more than 18 million street children in India. Poor parents don't have enough resources to send their children to school. The children often end up doing domestic chores or rag-picking and other anti-social activities.

El Shaddai need to raise \$42000 over the next 3 years to ensure the continuance of this crucial support for slum children. This project will allow children from these uniquely marginalized communities in Goa, India to stay off the streets and thrive in mainstream school environments.

Currently, the project program is run in 8 slums, and it provides multi-grade teaching where students of different age groups and levels of learning are taught under one roof. Funding will provide school supplies, fees and meals along with free health and medical care.

Education is a dream for millions of children who struggle to survive daily. The Slum School Project brings school home and will provide 1000 first generation learners with excellent education, which will put them on the path toward breaking the pervasive cycles of poverty in their slum communities.
